

Height and Weight Information

Height and weight restrictions have been established for the safety of our guests and follow the ride manufacturer's safety guidelines for each attraction. For additional information and safety guidelines please read our safety signs posted at the base of each attraction. Should you have any questions regarding an attraction please ask a lifeguard or contact Guest Services.

Only Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted. Complimentary life jackets are available at the wave pool and lazy river entrances.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q. Do I have to purchase a ticket even if I'm not riding any slides or getting into the water?

A. Regardless of a guests level of participation, whether or not a guest plans on riding slides or getting into the water a ticket is required for admission. [Ticket prices](#) remain the same for all guests.

Q. Can I bring in my own snacks and drinks?

A. We do not allow any outside food or beverages with the exception of factory sealed bottled water. Coolers are NOT permitted. Guests with special dietary needs are recommended to contact the park prior to their visit at 702-979-1600 or email: info@wetnwildlasvegas.com.

Q. Are coolers allowed in the park to keep water cold?

A. Coolers of any type, both hard and soft walled, or size are not permitted. Cold water and ice is available at no cost inside the park at a variety of locations.

Q. What can I wear?

A. Appropriate bathing suits are required. No shorts, cutoffs or items with metal fasteners, rivets, zippers or buckles are allowed on the slides. Clothing and bathing suits must be appropriate for a family friendly environment. Clothing depicting illegal substances, profanity, or gang affiliation is prohibited. Water socks are permitted on all slides and attractions with the exception of Slideboarding.

Q. Do you have to pay to park?

A. Yes, all vehicles are required to pay to park with the exception of school and tour busses or 15 passenger vans which are free. Gold and VIP Season Pass holders receive free parking as well. [More information & prices](#)

Q. Can we buy a parking pass?

A. The Gold and VIP Season Pass includes parking. No other parking passes are available for sale.

Q. How much does it cost to upgrade my Season Pass to a Gold Pass?

A. Upgrading a Silver Pass to a Gold Pass or Gold Pass to VIP Pass allows you to apply the amount paid for the Season Pass towards the next Season Pass option such as Silver to Gold or Gold to VIP. The price to upgrade to the next Season Pass level may vary depending on the advertised sales price at the time of the upgrade. The prices and availability for Season Passes are subject to change throughout the season.

Q. How much do lockers cost?

A. The Park has three different locker sizes available for purchase. Locker rentals are not included with park admission. All locker rentals are all day rentals. [More information & prices](#)

Q. Can I reserve a cabana?

A. Cabanas may be reserved in advance by visiting any open ticket window, calling 702-979-1600 or emailing the park. [More information & prices](#)

Q. What do I do if I want to leave the park and come back?

A. When exiting the park you will receive a re-entry hand stamp. If you leave the parking lot, you may re-enter the lot without paying for parking as long as you show your original parking receipt. Do not leave parking receipt in the sun. Parking receipts are printed on thermal paper and will turn black if left in the sun.

Q. What if I get separated from my child(ren)/parents?

A. We have trained staff and an action plan to assist reuniting separated children and parents. Please visit the Security Office, located next to Baja Surf Supply at the park's main gate for assistance.

Q. Do you provide lifejackets?

A. Lifejackets are provided at no cost in a variety of sizes. Lifejackets are located on both side of the shallow end of the Red Rock Bay and entrance to the Colorado Cooler. Guests can bring their own lifejackets, however they must be Coast Guard approved. This approval will be noted on the life vest.

Q. Do you provide or rent towels?

A. The park does not provide towels to guests nor is there an ability to rent towels. We encourage all of our guests to bring a beach towel with them when they visit. We do have towels available for purchase just inside the park's main gate at Baja Surf Supplies.

Q. Are you able to bring your own shade?

A. In an on-going effort to offer a safe and enjoyable environment for all park guests, Pop-up shade structures or other shade devices requiring rope tie-downs are no longer permitted for use in the park. Guests preferring to bring personal shade are restricted to low-profile devices that can be securely anchored to the ground. The park staff reserves the right to approve/allow use of any personal shade devices. In the event of high winds situations, the park may require shade devices to be lowered and secured until conditions improve.
