



COVID-19 Safety Update: May 22, 2021

The Florida Aquarium follows guidelines mandated by local government and health authorities. To allow for physical distancing, The Florida Aquarium's guest capacity is limited and some activities may not be available. **Guests who purchase tickets from a 3rd party do not need advance reservations**; simply bring your voucher/ticket to the Guest Services desk upon arrival for redemption and to enter at the first available time slot. If the Aquarium is at maximum capacity, guests will have to wait before they may enter.

Effective Saturday, May 22, in line with the latest CDC guidance, fully-vaccinated guests have the option to no longer wear a mask while visiting The Florida Aquarium. Masks are still required for unvaccinated guests (including children between the ages of 3 and 11) while inside the Aquarium. All Aquarium staff and volunteers will continue to wear face coverings regardless of vaccination status." Other guidelines are in place; please review them at www.flaquarium.org/reopen.

Official Aquarium parking is located 1 block north of The Florida Aquarium at the corner of Channelside Drive and York Street. The cost is \$10 per vehicle, payable by major credit card only (Visa, Mastercard, American Express) at the gate; no cash please.
