The state-of-the-art *Mystère* Theater at Treasure Island was the first permanent *Cirque du Soleil* theater built to the exact show specifications. This jewel of a theater provides a dreamlike, mystical and vibrant atmosphere as the backdrop to the *Mystère* performance. The theater offers no bad seats and is big enough to accommodate a large crowd while maintaining an intimate feeling.



Fun Facts

- 11,000 gallons of liquid nitrogen, enough to fill a backyard pool, are stored behind the upstage wall.
- If the show cable was laid out end-to-end it would stretch from Treasure Island on Las Vegas Boulevard to the Californian border.
- To create custom-designed hats, precise measurements of each of the artist's heads are taken by a portable scanner and the milliners build the hats with the help of 3D prints obtained with these figures.
- The estimated number of total costume pieces in the theater is approximately 10,000.
- There are more than 1,500 pairs of shoes in the wardrobe; The Male Lizard goes through one pair of shoes a week.
- The Bungee Girl costumes have more than 2,500 different colored sequins on them and each sequin is applied by hand.
- The international cast consists of 75 performers. The youngest is 21 and the oldest is 81.
- More than 700 additional hours of training is done per year.
- More than 110 bounces on the trampoline and more than 65 teeterboard jumps are performed during one show.
